## Conversations About School

There are ways to be involved in your child's education in addition to volunteering in the classroom. Research shows that supporting your child at home is even more important than helping in the classroom. Here are some ways that you can be involved while having a conversation with your child.

### "Let's see what you brought home."

Look at completed work to find out what your child is learning and how well s/he is doing. Compliment your child on his/her work. You might say, "You know a lot about our state's history!" Also, be sure to respond to notes from the teacher, and sign his/her weekly folder or daily planner if required.

### AFTER-SCHOOL QUESTIONS

Asking "How was school today?" might not get you far. Instead, ask questions like these for a better picture of your child's day:

- "What's the coolest thing that happened? What wasn't so cool?"
- "Pretend you're the teacher. How would you describe the day?"
- "What made you laugh?"
- "What was the most creative thing you did?"
- "How were you kind or helpful today? Was anyone kind or helpful to you?"

### "Show me what you have for homework."

It's your child's responsibility to do his/her homework, but you play a role, also. Make sure s/he knows what the expectation is by having him/her explain the assignment to you. After your child is finished, glance over the work to be sure it is complete.

### "Tell me what you learned that you'd like to know more about."

Use your child's interests as jumping-off points for activities to share. If s/he likes geometry, you might "hunt" for shapes together. If s/he's fascinated by how animals adapt to winter, take him/her to the library to research the subject or to the zoo to see live animals.
