Car Rider Parent Alert!

In addition to the following directions, we ask that parents who are lined up along the curbs move over as close to the curbs as possible. This will allow our buses to pass safely and deliver our bus riders on time.

- Please be sure to practice your child's car tag number with your child. If your child does not yet know the car rider number, please write it on his/her hand.
- Everyone who is a regular car rider should have a car tag to hang from the rearview mirror. Please have your tag visible in the car rider line.
- If you do not have a car rider tag, we will check your ID before we put a child in your car.
- Please remain in your vehicle and have your child practice opening and closing the car door.

EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION

The district is moving toward a paperless system with emergency cards. With this being said, you will not receive a copy of your child's emergency card for you to edit, add, and delete information. When calling and/or emailing, you will be required to provide the following information for the change to be made.

FOR ANY CHANGES BEING MADE

- Student's date of birth (needed for verification)
- Student's home address (needed for verification)

TO ADD NAMES TO LIST

- Name to add (must be legal name) or delete
- If adding, relationship to student
- Person's phone number
- Phone type (cell, home, daytime, etc)
- Permission to pick up- yes or no
