DISTRICT-WIDE *Remote Learning*

Monday, November 2 will be our first district-wide remote learning day. This, and the other scheduled remote days, will help ensure our teachers, students, and technology department are prepared for any extended remote learning for our school and/or district. Monday will be an asynchronous learning day, which means that students will work at their own pace by viewing pre-recorded lessons and completing assignments through the learning platforms.

Students who receive intervention (ELL, Rtl, SPED, and Monday Speech sessions) have the opportunity to meet with their interventionist via Zoom during their assigned time on these days. Please message your child's teacher via Dojo if you have any questions throughout the day. We completely understand that there is a learning curve for parents, students, and teachers. We are all in this together.

TRADITIONAL vs. VIRTUAL





Synchronous
Synchronous learning will follow the schedule sent via email on Friday. Students will have access to live instruction through Zoom lessons.

Asynchronous
Asynchronous learning will include pre-recorded lessons and assignments to complete through the learning platforms. Completion of these lessons/assignments occurs at the student's own pace. If your child receives intervention, s/he may access the interventionist using the Zoom links provided in the email you received on Friday.
