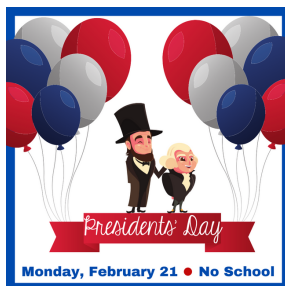
NEW CAR RIDER POLICY

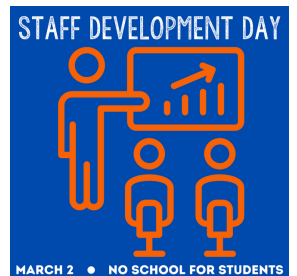


MORNING DROP-OFF
