## Student SAFETY

We cannot stress to you enough the importance of putting down your devices while driving on campus. It is against the law to have a cellular device in your hands while driving in the state of Tennessee. We have offered multiple reminders to our drivers, but still have parents talking on hand-held devices while driving on Sango's campus. There have been a few close calls because of distracted drivers. This is the final reminder and warning we will issue regarding this concern. Deputy Sacco is prepared to issue written warning and citations if you are caught on your phone while on school property. We will always choose the safety of our students above all else.

**TN Code § 55-8-207 (2017) It is an offense for a person to knowingly operate a motor vehicle in any marked school zone in this state, when a warning flasher or flashers are in operation, and talk on a hand-held mobile telephone while the vehicle is in motion.**

We ask that you also be mindful of pedestrians walking alongside the curb. They have the right-of-way. Please be sure to give them enough room to walk to school safely.



## Treats

We love celebrating birthdays and other special events with your children. However, when baked treats are brought to school, not all students are able to enjoy them due to allergies and food sensitivities. If you are bringing or sending treats to school, please consider small toys, pencils, etc, instead of food. This helps to ensure that all students are included. We know you would never wish for a student to feel left out. If you still wish to send in food items, they must be brought in before lunch so they can be approved by the classroom teacher and nurse for all students in the classroom. All food sent/brought in must be store-bought with an ingredient label. Treats may not be brought in at lunch time by visitors and distributed to students. Please let your child's teacher know if you plan to send something in. This helps them to be sure all students are able to participate.

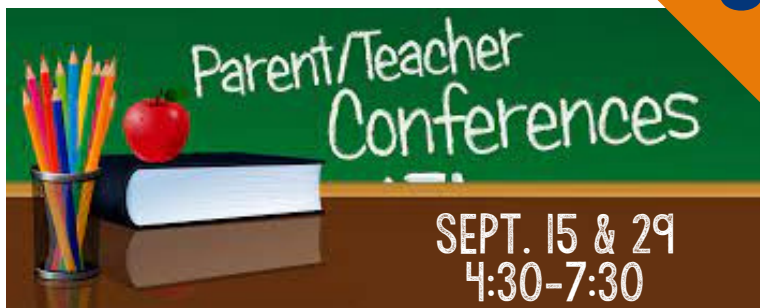
## Grandparents Day
