BOOSTER THON

It's that time again...BOOSTERTHON! At Sango, we absolutely love Boosterthon season for so many reasons. Yes, this program allows our PTO to raise funds which support our school, but it is so much more than money. The Boosterthon team that comes to Sango helps to reinforce many of those life skills and lessons that we, as parents, wish to instill in them. This year, our character theme is GRAND LAND ADVENTURE, a national parks theme all about building character through the rugged beauty and wild wonders of the great outdoors. By exploring some of the most iconic national parks in America, students will learn how to live a life of adventure and character.

THE STORY: One summer, a group of three cousins discovers a mysterious message from their late grandfather, a legendary National Parks ranger. In it, he explains that he's hidden a vast treasure somewhere inside a national park. But to find it, they first must watch a series of documentaries about five iconic national parks and figure out which character trait each park represents. With the help of your students and a mysterious puzzle box, they might just be able to find the buried treasure before summer ends. From the rugged tundra of Denali to the sweeping swamplands of the Everglades, our dynamic, documentary-style videos will allow your students to explore legendary parks like Yosemite, Acadia, Denali, Zion, and the Everglades. In the process, your students will learn about Gratitude, Stewardship, Bravery, Perseverance, and Wonder.

While we ask for your monetary support throughout this exciting week, more than that, we are very excited for our students to embark on this journey through the national parks while building character in new and different ways. The culminating event is on Friday, October 7, with the Fun Run.



3RD GRADE RETENTION LAW

Based on Tennessee law, T.C.A. 49-6-3115, passed in 2021, third-grade students who don't show proficiency on the English Language Arts (ELA) section of the Tennessee Comprehensive Program (TCAP) may have requirements related to summer school and/or tutoring to be promoted to fourth grade. We are working on a plan to support all of our students and we will be communicating with all of our third grade families after the upcoming ELA benchmark to share our student's progress toward mastery of standards. We will continue to communicate that progress with you throughout the year. We understand that there may be changes to the legislation, therefore we are not making any final decisions at this point. Our goal is to make sure we are meeting the needs of every student and supporting them in mastering grade level standards.
